Construction of Milpark Precinct Development: NMT Implementation

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders for the construction of Milpark Precinct non-motorised transport infrastructure, pedestrian walkways, provision of formalised parking, extensive lighting and street furniture provision, treatment of road surfaces at pedestrian crossings and use of the raised intersections, road upgrades as well as soft and hard landscaping along the route.

The successful tenderer will be expected to manage the component of the emerging sub-contractors who will be responsible for executing the portions of the work.

It is estimated that each tenderer should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or higher. Registered Contractors will be eligible to tender.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.
