Jabulani Transit-oriented Development - Phase 6: Multipurpose Sports Facility

The Johannesburg Development Agency invites tenders from construction companies for the upgrade of the Jabulani Transit-oriented Development - Phase 6. The scope of works entails upgrading of an existing road, stormwater, sidewalks and bulk earthworks, etc.

Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 8CE or higher. Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE class of construction work.

Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that they satisfy criteria stated in the tender data.
