1. INTRODUCTION

The JDA is requesting proposals from interested and qualified Geotechnical Service providers who are registered with the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) or Council of Geosciences making use of SANAS registered Geotechnical laboratories for the implementation of Health Preparatory Clinics over a period of 36 Months (September 2022 – September 2025).

2. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

The Scope of Works includes, the planning, design and implementation of health facilities.

The Geotechnical Engineering Consultant is required to be registered or familiar with acts and code of conduct of an appropriate professional body (i.e. ECSA/Geoscience), and to have the relevant professional accreditation (i.e. registered as Pr. or Pr. Tech Eng./Pr. Sci. Nat), skills, experience and capacity to deliver the scope of work within the required time frame.

The Geotechnical Engineering Consultant will be responsible for the survey that will assist the consultant with the design.

2.1 Location and Description

THE DETAILED GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SURVEY WILL BE CARRIED OUT AS PER THE FOLLOWING SCOPE OF WORKS:

6.1 Desktop Study

The desktop study shall include the review and assessment of existing information as indicated below but not limited to:

- (a) Existing reference reports
- (b) Geological Maps, etc

6.2 Field Investigation

The investigation shall include the following but not limited to:

- a. Test Pitting and Profiling to describe the ground condition underlying the site.
- b. Laboratory Testing of samples from test pits for tests including, Foundation Indicator, California Bearing Ration (CBR) and Collapse Potential testing to determine basic engineering characteristics including:

- Atterberg Limits (plastic limit, liquid limit and plasticity index)
- Potential Expansiveness
- Collapse Potential
- Grading Analysis and
- MOD AASHTO Density and CBR

- c. All field investigation shall be undertaken under strict supervision of a Professionally Registered Geotechnical Engineer.

6.4 GEOTECHNICAL REPORT

6.4.1 Report Content

Based on the investigation as illustrated above and the soil classification parameters, the report shall discuss the assessment of the following geotechnical characteristics but not limited to:

- i. Existing geotechnical (e.g. surface and subsurface) conditions of the site.
- ii. Laboratory test results of the existing site surface samples should be taken at the intervals specified the relevant
- iii. Subsurface (substrata) exploration logs, location of exploration points, soil bearing capacity, etc. and recommendations.
- iv. Conducting all field and laboratory tests for determining the strength and compressibility characteristics of the soil.
- v. Geophysical exploration, if necessary.
- vi. Slope and rock stability evaluation, protection measures.
- vii. Preparation of drawings and charts.
- viii. Analysis of the results of the tests.
- ix. Groundwater conditions
- x. Soil Classification.

The Geotechnical Investigation Report shall be signed by a Professionally Registered Geotechnical Engineer.

Submissions are to consist of a short (**not to exceed 10 pages**) and comprehensible report that must provide the JDA with sufficient information to make a sound and fair evaluation of the quotation as well as the experience and capability of the applicant to undertake and manage the project successfully. Compliance

- Who's tender document has been completed in pencil;
- Who's tender document has been faxed;

- Who's tender document has not been deposited in the tender box at the time of closing;
- Who did not comply with any other requirement as set out in the tender specifications;

- 7.2.1 “B-BBEE status level of contributor” means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act (Act No.53 of 2003).
- 7.2.2 Tenderers must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating. Certificates issued by either verification agencies accredited by the South African Accreditation System (SANAS) or by registered auditors approved by the Independent Regulatory Board for Auditors (IRBA) are acceptable.
- 7.2.3 An EME must submit a sworn affidavit confirming the following:
- Annual Turnover Revenue of R10 million or less; and
 - Level of Black ownership
 - Any misrepresentation in terms of bullet point above constitutes a criminal offence as set out in the B-BBEE Act as amended.
- 7.2.4 The submission of such certificates must comply with the requirements of instructions and guidelines issued by the National Treasury and be in accordance with notices published by the Department of Trade and Industry in the Government Gazette.
- 7.2.5 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits their B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 7.2.6 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate tender.
- 7.2.7 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the tender documents that such a tenderer intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a tenderer qualifies for.

- 7.2.8 A person awarded a contract will not be permitted to sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned.

7.3 Price and Empowerment

Having completed a technical evaluation, the procedure for the evaluation of technically qualifying tenders is Method 2 (Price and Preferences). The Preference Point System assigns a score to each tenderer based on the tender price and on the tenderer's BBEE status. These scores are combined to determine an overall score for the tender. The tender with the highest score will be considered for acceptance.

The Preference Point System will be applied as follows:

- 80 points are assigned to price
- Up to 20 points are assigned to BBEE status per the table under item 7.2

The total preference points for a tender are calculated with the formula

PP = P_s + P_{bee} Where

PP is the total number of preference points scored by the tenderer

P_s is the points scored for the comparative price of the tenderer, and

P_{bee} is the number of points awarded to the tenderer based on his certified B-BBEE status level

Formula for scoring tender price

The following formula will be used to calculate the points for price.

$$P_s = X \left[1 - \frac{(P_t - P_{min})}{P_{min}} \right]$$

Where

P_s = Points scored for comparative price of tender under consideration

P_t = Comparative price of tender under consideration

P_{min} = Comparative price of lowest acceptable tender

X = Points assigned to price
